MINUTES OF MEETING HELD 31ST OCTOBER 1983 IN THE COMMUNITY HALL, TRAWDEN

2. MINUTES: Minutes of meeting held 26th September approved and adopted. on the 22nd November. Three members were appointed to the sub-committee, Mrs. Robinson, Mr. Haley and Mr. Robertson attended the meeting and found it both interesting and beneficial. together during the Christmas period and it was agreed
3. MATTERS ARISING:

Mr. Haley suggested we should write to Pendle Borough Council asking if the open yard could be made into a recreation area and asking if someone could meet the Planning and Development Officer to discuss the idea. Resolved to ask the Highways Department Mr. Schofield re Talk on Trawden - No reply as yet.
 - Tipping in Quarry at Winewall - Reported that the County Council, Burnley Depot, have tidied up the quarry.
4. CORRESPONDENCE:
 - Toilets at bottom of Rock Lane - Reported that the necessary repairs have been carried out.
 - Craft Centre, Wycoller - Letter from Planning & Development Officer saying that notices of the proposal were not displayed because the application had been submitted in outline form only and he had written to the applicant for more details.
 - Letter from Lancashire Parish & Council's area committee giving details of next meeting to be held on 9th November.
 - Letter from Burnley & Pendle Joint Transport regarding community buses.
 - Letter from Mr. Eric Davis, Chairman of the Eastern Region of the Lancashire Trust for Nature Conservation giving details of a slide lecture to be presented in the Community Hall on 1st December.
 - Christmas Gifts for Persons aged 80 and over - Mr. Robertson said he would distribute the gifts and Mr. Haley offered to compile a list of eligible pensioners in the area. November 1983 at 7.30 p.m.
 - Remembrance Sunday - Letter from Pendle Borough Council. Mr. Robertson again offered to lay the wreath at the Cenotaph on behalf of the Neighbourhood Council.
 - Circular from Pendle & District Sports Council.The Chairman read out letters he had received in connection with the recent Village Show.
5. SOCIAL FUNCTIONS: The Chairman thanked Mrs. Stone for presenting a balance sheet following the Village Show. The Treasurer said a new account had

been opened under the title of 'Trawden Social Fund' and £50 deposited in it. She explained that it had never been intended that the Show should be a Neighbourhood Council function and that any future social events could use the new account. It was agreed that the next social function would be the Supper Dance and it was proposed to book the Hall for a Friday evening in February. Mr. Bleasdale proposed that a special sub-committee be formed and that more social events should be held in the village and this was seconded by Mr. Haley. A vote was taken but the proposal was defeated by four votes to three. It was then proposed by the Chairman, seconded by Mrs. Stone and passed unanimously that a small sub-committee should be set up to deal solely with the Village Show and that arrangements for the Supper Dance should be made on the same lines as previously. Suggested that a meeting should be held in the near future to make plans for the next Show with as many members as possible present and it was arranged to meet at the Sun Inn on the 22nd November. Three members were appointed to the sub-committee, namely David Robertson, Freda Stone and Nora Darcy. Mrs. Stone suggested that members and their spouses should have an evening out together during the Christmas period and it was agreed that she should make enquiries.

6. REVISION OF MINUTES: Mrs. Robinson said she had again received complaints about smells from Nicholl House Farm.

7. ANY OTHER BUSINESS: Reported that some fencing has been removed from around the Library and it was resolved to ask if the remainder could be removed. Also, to ask Leisure Services if some hedging could be planted in front of the car park. Mr. Haley said there was no signpost to Trawden on Keighley Road when travelling towards Colne. Resolved to ask the Highways Department to erect one.

Mr. Bleasdale stated that two lampstandards within the Trawden boundary had been marked with Colne numbers.

CORRESPONDENCE

Mrs. Robinson asked if there was any legislation within the Pendle area compelling sand-blasters to sheet up whilst operating. Resolved to enquire at the Environmental Health Office.

Mrs. Waterworth complained about cars speeding at the junction of Church St/Colne Rd/Burnley Rd. C.C. Sargeant suggested that the Borough Engineer be asked to bring the matter to the notice of the Traffic Management Committee. Suggested that a 'Halt' sign could be erected at the bottom of Burnley Road. Mrs. Waterworth said that 'School' signs were also badly needed near the bottom of Dean Street.

Mr. Armstrong suggested that items under 'Any Other Business' should be notified to the chairman or secretary before the meeting as some items could be put on the agenda. The Chairman asked members to bear this point in mind.

The meeting closed at 9.30 p.m.
