Hi Adele,

Please see the attached photo, you may have seen these shelter style in other areas. These are unpainted raw 316 stainless steel and the panel make up is predominantly glass.

The end panel on the image above is 200mm which is similar to the existing shelter in Trawden. This is subject to available footway widths, we need to maintain 1.2 metres footway clearance where possible after all street furniture is installed. We may be able to increase this at the location mentioned to provide better protection but would be subject to a site visit.
